Cascade Clamps - Established in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine shop employing only 4 people. Overall sales for that initial year amounted to about 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and different parts. Throughout 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to 40 workers and their yearly sales volume had risen to \$330,000. Nowadays, Cascade is one of the leading worldwide producers within the material handling industry.

Design and manufacturing of the company's original hydraulic cylinder allowed this young company to aggressively engage in new business opportunities. Throughout the last sixty years, the trade of material handling has developed into a really sophisticated field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its development. Cascade at the moment continues to develop as the premier provider of forklift attachments and numerous associated items. The business feels certain in their capability to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding customer's requirements in the future and remaining competitive in the global market.

In the 1950's, Cascade started designing, fabricating and advertising hydraulic attachments. Manufacturing was completed in 1956 on a brand new office to house all the office and plant operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's current headquarters. After fifteen years of business, total staff reached a hundred and eighty workers and sales had reached almost 2.3 million dollars.

A second manufacturing plant was built in 1959 in Springfield, El Cajon. The year 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the international world of the material handling industry while the business established interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

In 1964, the business changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Then in the year 1965, the company went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing facilities within the continental US to the areas Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Springfield, El Cajon and Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are fabricated worldwide due to many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new facility was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This facility is designed to be the essential customer service centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and the year 1997 with the dramatic acquisition of five corporations, including the international best in forks, the Kenhar Corporation.
